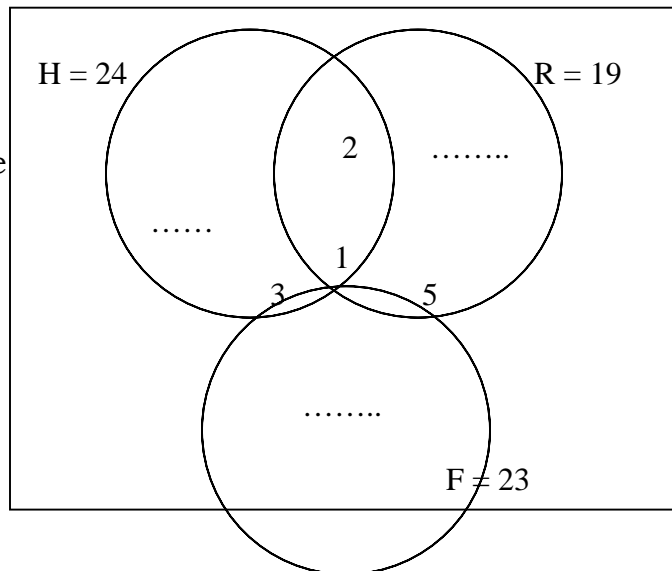
5. Using a ruler and a pair of compasses only construct a triangle PQR in which
